Instincts Agility Regulations

- All dogs must be vaccinated (proof of vaccination may be requested or veterinary letter in the case of homeopathic nosodes)
- Dogs should not be fed for 2 hours prior to a training session and 1 hour afterward to minimise possible gastric complications
- Bitches are welcome - but not when in season
- Dogs must be 12 months or over with the trainers' judgment on jumping
- The trainers decision with regard the fitness of the dog on any of the equipment is final
- Dogs must be known to be tolerant of other dogs around them and relatively controlled (a pre-training assessment may be requested by the discretion of the trainer)
- Dogs must be on a lead at all times unless instructed otherwise (lightweight webbing leads or light weight training leads are ideal)
- No check chains, half checks, slip leads or Illusion collars – leather/fabric smooth collars only
- Owners are responsible for providing their own poo bags and clearing up after their dog. Area must be sprayed with disinfectant spray – which is provided (there is a poo bucket available for disposal of filled poo bag)
- Food treats are advisable – as are toys for motivation. These must be what your dog is very keen on! (rope toys etc)
- Flat comfortable shoes and suitable weather gear are a must for owners!
- Cars are parked at owner's risk
